This kindergarten registration information is being distributed to the parents of elementary school children.

Registration of children who will reach five years of age by October 1 of this year will be held at Frank J. Smith School, 27 Green Drive.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Registration of children who will be **five years old on or before October 1, 2010**, will take place as follows:

On the above dates, parents/guardians are required to bring the following records:

1. **ORIGINAL** birth certificate
2. **DPT** - Evidence of at least four (4) doses of DPT vaccine is required. **ONE DOSE MUST BE GIVEN ON OR AFTER THE FOURTH BIRTHDAY.**
3. **ORAL POLIO** - A minimum of (3) doses of oral polio vaccine is required, provided **ONE DOSE IS GIVEN ON OR AFTER THE FOURTH BIRTHDAY.**
4. **MEASLES** - Evidence of one dose of measles vaccine **ON OR AFTER THE FIRST BIRTHDAY AND A SECOND DOSE OF MEASLES VACCINE**, preferably MMR. Laboratory documentation of measles is an acceptable alternative.
5. **GERMAN MEASLES (RUBELLA)** - Evidence of one dose of German measles (rubella) vaccine **ON OR AFTER THE FIRST BIRTHDAY.** Laboratory documentation of rubella immunity is an acceptable alternative.
6. **MUMPS** - Evidence of one dose of mumps vaccine **ON OR AFTER THE FIRST BIRTHDAY.** Acceptable alternatives are a doctor's certification of having had mumps or laboratory evidence of mumps immunity.
7. **HEPATITIS B** – Evidence of three doses of hepatitis B vaccine.
8. **CHICKEN POX (VARICELLA)** - Evidence of one dose of chicken pox (varicella) vaccine **ON OR AFTER THE FIRST BIRTHDAY.** Laboratory evidence of immunity or doctor's or parent's statement of previous chicken pox infection are acceptable alternatives.
9. **THREE** proofs of East Hanover residency such as a utility bill, tax bill, etc.
10. **Family Information Sheet**

Additionally, children must have a physical exam within one year before entering kindergarten. Medical forms are available at Frank J. Smith and on the district website, www.easthanoverschools.org.

Parents are encouraged to register even if all of the above documentation is not available. However, complete documentation **must be provided before the child can begin attending school.**

East Hanover's Kindergarten program is a half-day program. Your child will be placed in either the A.M. or P.M. session, based on the bus routes. **Please do not make any special requests for a specific session.**
